UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) is the principal deliberative, policymaking, and representative organ of the United Nations, where all 193 member states convene annually to discuss global issues. Immediate action is essential to mitigate these impacts.


